REPORTS FROM THE COMMITTEES

Scholarship –The Fred Ruffing Scholarship will be awarded to Marilyn Lockhart. This scholarship is in memory of ACCA's founder, Fred Ruffing.

Grants –The Lake Barcroft Women's Club made a donation of almost \$4,000 from the proceeds of their recent house and art tour.

Transportation – Twenty-two rides were provided in May.

Family Emergency Committee – ACCA assisted 35 households in May, with help totaling \$16,282. Of these, 21 households received rental assistance (\$10,799); 10 received help with utility bills (\$4,340); 3 for individual medicine assistance (\$793); and 1 miscellaneous (\$350). The beginning of June had much higher than normal requests for assistance.

Annandale Meals on Wheels – Volunteers delivered 845 meals in 21 days in May. Hasso von Breedow retired from his position as the driver coordinator for the Annandale Meals on Wheels program, after many years of service. We appreciate all of Hasso's service. We also thank Margaret Norris for her work assisting in phoning drivers. We are pleased to report that Tom Dameron is our new driver coordinator, and his wife, Bev Dameron, will assist with phoning.

ACCA Food Pantry – During May, food pantry volunteers made 33 deliveries to a total of 93 individuals. The Annandale Post Office food drive brought in many donations of canned and nonperishable food. Volunteers from the Annandale Ward of the Church of Latter Day Saints helped transport the food from the Post Office to the food pantry.

Furniture and House Wares –In the month of May, Furniture Ministry crews completed 46 pickups and deliveries. The House Wares Ministry assisted three families during May. The ministry is currently housed at Glencarlyn Road Baptist Church, but the Church is seeking a new home for the house ware ministry.

CROP Walk- The 2005 CROP Walk is being planned for October 22. ACCA is sponsoring a CROP Walk Poster contest. The goal of the contest is to help children learn about hunger in our community and around the world, and to help publicize the walk. Entries will be due October 1.
